







# 1- mini BUMPY PYRAMIDS

Egyptian Pyramids are ancient pyramid-shaped structures located in Egypt. As of November 2008, the number of pyramids identified is between 118 and 138. The vast majority of the pyramids were built as mausoleums for the pharaohs and their wives of the Old Kingdom and Middle Kingdom.



## 2- mini VOLCANO GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE

The Golden Gate Bridge is a suspension bridge over the Golden Gate Strait at the entrance to San Francisco Bay in California. Currently, it is the 19th longest suspension bridge in the world. The length of the bridge is 2.73 km, the distance between the piers is 1.28 km, and its height reaches 235 meters. There are six lanes for vehicular traffic. The bridge connects San Francisco with the northern parts of Marin County and the more sparsely populated Napa and Sonoma Valley.



### 3- mini BABY BURJ AL ARAB

The Burj Al is a luxury hotel in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. Developed and managed by Jumeirah, it is one of the tallest hotels in the world, although 39% of its total height is made up of non-occupiable space. Arab Burj Al Arab stands on an artificial island that is 280 m (920 ft) from Jumeirah Beach and is connected to the mainland by a private curving bridge. The shape of the structure is designed to resemble the sail of a dhow. It has a helipad near the roof, at a height of 210 m (689 ft) above ground.



## 4- mini CHIPPING TOWER OF PISA

The Leaning Tower of Pisa is the bell tower of the city cathedral, located in Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles in Italian) in the historical city of Pisa in Italy, built between 1063-1090, separately from the main structure, between 1173-1272. Although there is no clear information about the architecture of its construction for 99 years, it is estimated that it was built by Architects Bonnano Pisano and Diotisalvi. It was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1987.



## 5- mini RACKET

### WINDMILL

Windmills are known worldwide as an iconic symbol of Dutch culture. A windmill is a structure that converts wind power into rotational energy using vanes called sails or blades, by tradition specifically to mill grain (gristmills), but in some parts of the English-speaking world, the term has also been extended to encompass windpumps, wind turbines, and other applications. The term wind engine is also sometimes used to describe such devices.



## 6- mini FOOTPRINT

### BIG BEN TOWER

Big Ben is the famous clock tower next to the Palace of Westminster in London. It is the second largest four-faced clock in the world. "Big Ben" is actually the name of the bell of the clock tower, but over time it has come to be used by the public to refer to the entire structure. The tower was designed in neo-Gothic style by Augustus Pugin. When completed in 1859, its clock was the largest in the world. The tower is 316 feet (96 m) high and the climb from ground level to the bell tower is 334 steps.

All four nations of England are represented on the tower in shields that include a rose for England, thistles for Scotland, shamrocks for Northern Ireland and leeks for Wales.

### EIFFEL TOWER

Eiffel Tower, iron tower in Paris. The tower has also become the symbol of France all over the world. It takes its name from the French civil engineer Gustave Eiffel, who built it. One of the biggest tourism attractions, the Eiffel Tower attracts 6 million tourists annually. In 2002, the total number of visitors reached 200 million.




## 8- mini RAMP

### MOAI




Moai are monolithic human figures carved by the Rapa Nui people on Rapa Nui (Easter Island) in eastern Polynesia between the years 1250 and 1500. Nearly half are still at Rano Raraku, the main moai quarry, but hundreds were transported from there and set on stone platforms called ahu around the island's perimeter. Almost all moai have overly large heads, which account for three-eighths of the size of the whole statue. They also have no legs.

## 9- mini HORSESHOE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING

Empire State Building is a skyscraper in New York. On May 1, 1931, it was taken away from the Chrysler Building, which was the tallest building in the world until that day. Its construction was completed in 1932. Built in 1931, the building's offices remained vacant throughout the Great Depression; The building was able to cover its tax expenses from those who came to watch the view. The building has 102 floors and 1576 stair steps. Its height is 381 m and 443.2 m with the antenna.
